It was a heartwarming and wonderful feeling because it was at the time when our country was in a political crisis and we were struck by the lethal 3rd wave of COVID virus. To date, the virus is still killing people in different states and the situation in the villages are worst.

In Myanmar, it was really difficult to buy Oxygen Concentrator and Oxygen Cylinder. During that critical period, every day, every hour I received phone calls from friends and relatives, asking for oxygen equipment. Because they were very expensive, we could not afford. It was heart breaking to see friends and relatives passed away because of not getting oxygen supply in time. As our country political problem deepened, situation got worst and all we could do was to pray.

Words cannot describe our appreciation except to say “Thank you so much Captain Yang, ALPA-S and SIA”.

When Captain Yang called on 21 Jul, Pastor Joe, my father 84, was already not well, so was another 90 year-old Grandpa staying with Full Moon. It was a time that Oxygen Concentrator was so hard to find and we also could not find donation to buy it. Miraculously he could arrange the machine to come in a week! Arrived on 28th Jul, in time to save my father and the old grandpa. If the machine was to come late, the outcome would be catastrophic.

Please allow me to share more words of thanks from my mum. In Aug, my mum, 85 year-old was suffering from imminent heart failure and oxygen supply was urgently needed. In Yangon, if you are not well or if you have an emergency, it will be difficult to get a vacancy in the hospital. The pandemic and political crisis made it near impossible to see doctors, let alone to be warded with supplementary oxygen. When our doctor mentioned "...the only solution for your mum's survival was to have oxygen to supplement her breathing at home". At that time of crisis in our country, I could confidently answered "Yes, we can!". This could not happen without ALPA-S' blessing of oxygen concentrator and oxygen cylinders.
